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Subject : The new version of “My Tax Account” system allows taxpayers to check 9 items of their eligible tax allowances

The new version of “My Tax Account” system provides personal tax data and services on the Revenue Department’s website. Taxpayers can check 9 items of their eligible tax allowances before filing P.N.D. 90 or P.N.D.91, track refund status and submit any supporting document required with greater confidentiality and data safeguard standards.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) as a spokesperson of the Revenue Department said that “for taxpayers’ convenience, the Revenue Department has developed “My Tax Account” system as an online channel for taxpayers to access their personal tax data and services. The system provides taxpayers’ information on 9 items of tax allowances, including Social Security Fund contributions, health insurance premiums, charitable donations via e-donation, Government Pension Fund (GPF) contributions, life insurance premiums, annuity insurance premiums, health insurance premiums for parents, interests paid on home loans (in case of one borrower) and National Saving Fund (NSF) contributions. For government officials, there is also information on taxable incomes under Section 40 (1) of the Revenue Code and withholding tax in corresponding to data from the Comptroller General’s Department. The information on “My Tax Account” is pre-filled on an online personal income tax return. Taxpayers can also check their tax refund status as well as submit any supporting documents required.”

The Revenue Department’s spokesperson added that “the information on “My Tax Account” is provided by related external agencies. In case taxpayers find out that it is incorrect and incomplete, they can contact relevant agencies. Apart from improving taxpayers’ convenience, the Revenue Department has enhanced confidentiality and data safeguard standards on authentication processes of “My Tax Account” system. A taxpayer must enter his/her username and password used for e-filing as well as the laser ID appeared at the back of the national identity card (for a Thai nationality). On top of that, one time password (OTP) verification is added to increase data security.”
