Subject : The Revenue Department encouraged taxpayers to file tax returns via internet

which have been extended until the end of the month to increase liquidity

The Revenue Department encouraged taxpayers to file all types of tax returns via internet, due to the filing and payment's extension until the end of August 2020. It is convenient, no need to travel and increase the liquidity for business.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) spokesman of the Revenue Department revealed that "According to the extension of filing and payment for all types of tax returns from March to August 2020, the extension includes filing and payment of Withholding Tax (P.N.D.1, P.N.D.2, P.N.D.3, P.N.D.53 and P.N.D.54), Value Added Tax on domestic sales of goods and services (P.P.30), Value Added Tax on oversea service payment (P.P.36) and Specific Business Tax (P.T.40). Only the entrepreneurs who files tax returns via internet are able to postpone the filing and payment to the end of the following month, for instance, the tax returns of May 2020 can be filed and paid via internet within 30<sup>th</sup> June 2020. This measure will help the entrepreneurs and business sectors affected from Covid-19 pandemic to increase their financial and operating liquidity, maintain the business, and promote social distancing campaign for everyone's safety."
