Subject	:	The Revenue Department has refunded individual taxpayers for more than
		33 billion Baht to boost individuals' cashflow

In the hope of increasing individuals' cashflow amid this ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, the Revenue Department has swiftly refunded 33,145.82 million Baht refund for those 3,075,237 taxpayers who have filed personal income tax returns in tax year 2019. These batches of refund are mostly operated to those who have made a refund request online with complete documents attached and have linked their PromptPay account with their Thai National ID Number.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) and Spokesperson of the Revenue Department stated that, "As of 9th August 2020, the Revenue Department has already considered and approved 3,075,237 tax refund requests for personal income tax returns (P.N.D.90 and P.N.D.91) of tax year 2019, and the total amount is 33,145.82 million Baht. This is expected to give a much needed boost to the economy as it would increase individuals' cashflow during this Covid-19 outbreak. It is shown that 90 percent of taxpayers who have already received the refund are those who filed tax returns online along with uploading all of the required documents and also linked their bank account with PromptPay system using Thai National ID number. Nonetheless, taxpayers who have not yet received the tax refund, the status can be tracked 24/7 at www.rd.go.th"

The Revenue Department spokesperson also made the following final remark that "For those who have not filed the personal income tax return (P.N.D. 90/91) for tax year 2019, the Revenue Department has extended its deadline to 31st August 2020. Moreover, we suggest that in order to receive a refund quickly, taxpayers should use e-Filing system via www.rd.go.th and link a bank account with PromptPay System using Thai National ID number."
